



PATHWAY THREE – RECOGNISED AUSTRALIAN STATE AND TERRITORY REGISTRATION 2009

Architects registered by any Australian State or Territory are entitled to be registered in New Zealand without having to be assessed, in accordance with the New Zealand Trans-Tasman Mutual Recognition Act 1997.

Recognised Registrations

Architects registered by any Australian State or Territory are entitled to be registered in New Zealand without having to be assessed, in accordance with the New Zealand Trans-Tasman Mutual Recognition Act 1997.

Registration Process

1. There is no practical experience requirement in New Zealand additional to that required to obtain registration in Australia for TTMRA applicants.
2. Applicants must provide proof of their state or territory registration and ability to practice.
